## ARIZONA STRONGHOLD VINEYARDS RESPONDS TO REQUESTS FOR A CABERNET SAUVIGNON... MEET *DALA*

CORNVILLE, Ariz., Nov. 1 -- Arizona Stronghold Vineyards has responded to an overwhelming number of requests for a Cabernet Sauvignon and created *Dala*, a new bottle that will launch this month.

"This is an age worthy wine with excellent acidity," explained Vineyard Founder and Director of Winemaking Eric Glomski. "I suggest pairing it with rich meats, cheeses and sauces."

The Bordeaux-like Cabernet Sauvignon's first vintage is 2009 and has a solid bouquet of black currant, cassis, spice cake and fennel. Nice depth of flavors and a rich persistent finish.

The vineyard makes the announcement as the inaugural year of Arizona Wine Week gets underway.
