**Region:** Arizona Stronghold's grapes are sourced from two vineyards located in South Eastern Arizona - Arizona Stronghold and Bonita Springs. Arizona Stronghold is located in the Sulfur Springs Valley and Bonita Springs lies at the foot of the Graham Mountains. The vineyards sit at an elevation of approximately 4300' and experience up to 50° fluctuations in diurnal temperatures during the growing season.
